#### 9th Annual Dinner Auction

Annually, we hold a dinner auction to help support the cost of educating our students. Since we are a parochial school, we do not receive any state funding. We do participate in the Federal Hot Lunch Program and are able to assist children through this program. The costs for teacher's salaries, utilities and the building up-keep, is the responsibility of the school and St. Columban Church. The generosity of those who support our dinner auction each year help keep our school open.

This year, our 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Dinner Auction will be held on Saturday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012. The evening's theme is "Rock n` Roll with Catholic Education", and the evening will be full of fun and excitement for all. The doors open at 4:00 p.m. for people to browse the silent auction rooms. At 6:30 p.m. we will have dinner, followed by a live auction. Because of the nature of the event, only individuals over the age of twenty-one will be allowed.

#### Catholic Schools Week, January 29th through February 4th

This is the 39th time that Catholic Schools Week has been held. The first year was in 1974.

This year the theme focuses on three priorities that Catholic schools establish that make them stand out from other educational institutions. Children are taught faith – not just the basics of Christianity, but how to have a relationship with God. Academics, which in Catholic schools are held to very high standards and help each child reach his or her potential. Service, the giving of one's time and effort to help others, is taught both as an expression of faith and good citizenship.

#### Easy Fundraisers for Bishop Hogan Memorial School That You Can Help With

The 2nd Tuesday of the month we team up with Pizza Hut's Dough 4 Schools to raise money for the school. Flyers are sent home with the students or they are available that evening at Pizza Hut. All we have to do is get our family and friends to order pizza for dinner that night. The flyers have to be turned in to Pizza Hut when you pick up your pizza. We then receive 15% of all sales that have flyers that night; also the teacher with the most total dollars for the night wins a pizza party for their class. The 4th Thursday of the month we team up with Dominos Pizza's Dough Raising Night. It is basically done the same way, flyers go home with the students the day before and they must be turned in when you purchase your pizza. We make \$1.00 off of every pizza from Dominos no matter what size. In December we only made \$20.00 so we need to try to do better this month, January 26th. Like Pizza Hut the teacher with the most total dollar amount wins a pizza party for their class, last month Emily Constant's class won. Please take advantage of a night off from cooking and help the school raise money.
